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## About the meeting

In the near future, Medicine (*and Cardiology*) will be more and more tailored. Today we cure “the illness”, but tomorrow we will treat “the patient”. Soon the Individual genome will be available in few hours and at a low cost as well as the whole set of proteins (*Proteoma*) and bio processes (*Metaboloma*). It follows that before administering the therapy, we would map all the possible variables. Thus apply the “so called” Precision Medicine.

There’s no doubt that cardiologists have to be up-to-date in order to keep up with the times. For this reason we have organized a day dedicated to Cardiogenetics, with a particular focus on arrhythmic death and cardiomyopathies. The shape of the meeting (*intentionally direct, educational, and practical*) is focused on an update on a cardiogenetic aspects, on the presentation of our Centre, and to the possible effective collaborations. This second part will be treated in Italian.

## What is special of the meeting

This is not, however, the only purpose of the meeting. There are several inequalities around the world, including that not all the children born with congenital heart disease have access to adequate care. All the chairmen, speakers, and discussants are volunteers, no fees, all travel and lodging expenses are covered by themselves! The University of Ferrara provides the location and audiovisual without any charges and FASC donates the organizing secretariat, coffee breaks, and lunches. MTA will be responsible for ECM, logistic etc. So, basically, the surplace of the meeting will be forwarded by MTA to European Heart for Children, a humanitarian foundation supported by the ESC and the cardiovascular Center of the University of Ferrara.
